Call for papers

U-MOB LIFE "European Network for Sustainable Mobility at University" is a European 5-year project co-financed by the European Commission under the LIFE Programme. The main goal of this project is to create a European Network for Sustainable Mobility at universities, in order to facilitate the exchange and transfer of knowledge about the best practices of sustainable mobility across universities. This network will serve as a step towards the reduction of CO₂ emissions from the university's community mobility (more information about the project can be found here: www.u-mob.eu).

One of the project activities, which is aimed at raising awareness on sustainable university mobility, is a series of conferences. Next year, the Cracow University of Technology will be the organizer of the 2nd European Conference on Sustainable Mobility at Universities. This event will take place from March 14th to 15th, 2019 in Krakow (Poland).

We invite universities to present their experiences, both on best practices and problematic issues, regarding university transport supply and mobility. The conference topics will be as follows:

-  pedestrian mobility
-  bicycle traffic
-  public transport for campus users
-  curricular system for sustainable mobility
-  working time and class organization
-  land use and spatial planning (how to create a multifunctional campus? how to improve space quality? how to connect campuses with transport connections?)
-  more efficient car usage
-  use of new technologies for university mobility
-  informational and promotional activities

A debate will be also organized on the second day of the conference, during which the issue of cooperation for sustainable mobility between different universities as well as transport operators and units managing the transport systems will be discussed.

If you have your own idea that surrounds this topic that should be discussed during the conference, or if you would like to present any best practice of your university on a topic not listed above, please let us know. All opinions and suggestions will be collected, and we will try to include the most interesting ones in the conference program.
