Introduction to the Training Course on Sustainable Mobility Management in Universities

The university is a great place to start changing the mobility paradigm, not only because a university's mobility plan can relate to public policies and start a change in the transport system of a city, but also because students will learn to understand the positive impacts of moving in a sustainable way. The university mobility manager is the representative of the university in sustainable mobility issues. He/she is responsible for planning and managing the mobility related to students and university staff, and gathers different knowledge and capabilities covering all aspects related to transport means and sustainability (technical, social, economic and environmental aspects), which must be perfectly integrated and coordinated in order to develop a mobility strategy.

In the first module of this course, you will be introduced to the key concepts needed to prepare and to put a Sustainable Mobility Plan (SMP) into practice. To guarantee the successful implementation of a SMP, the mobility manager must maintain a good relationship with stakeholders to tackle mobility issues, both inside

4.1.1 Reading the modules
