



FAQs

1 HOW EARLY CAN I APPLY TO PARTICIPATE?

In principle, confirming your participation 24 hours before would be enough. Then, you could attach the signed Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) later.

2 WHO HAS TO SIGN THE MOU?

The signature can be made by the rector or any person with the highest responsibility, such as vice chancellor or mobility manager, among others.

3 HOW LONG WILL THE TOURNAMENT LAST?

The tournament will last 8 weeks within the two stipulated months, officially beginning on 20 September and ending on 13 November.

4 HOW ARE THE POINTS COUNTED?

Points will be counted per number of sustainable kilometers.

5 HOW DOES ONE START COMPETING?

The user starts the manual route, chooses the route and, depending on the speed, checks that he/she is in the transport he/she declares.

6 WHO AWARDS THE PRIZES, WHERE AND WHEN THEY ARE COLLECTED?

The prizes are awarded by the U·MOB LIFE project. Winners will be announced during the U·MOB Online Final Conference (17-19 November). There will be 3 prizes for the 3 best players, and a trophy for the winning university. Prizes will have to be chosen from a catalogue that will be provided only to the winners. Once they have chosen their prizes, they will be sent to their university, and the shipping costs will be covered by U·MOB.
